MINUTES OF THE FEBRUARY 5, 2010 MEETING

President, Dan Fiedler, called the meeting to order at 7:00pm and began by thanking MacMulkin Chevrolet for the use of their facility.

Membership Director, Dennis Granger announced that there were no new members or prospective members in attendance.

There was not a Secretary's Report as the February Newsletter has not been published.

There was not a Treasurer's Report as Treasurer, Ruth Wintle is in Florida.

Officer at Large, Joe Michalik, read flyers and reviewed the mail sent to the club. A letter arrived from the National Corvette Museum as GCCC are charter members and our \$30.00 annual renewal is due. The Corvette Views Newsletter also arrived and was available for members to review after the meeting.

Vice President (and Activities Director), Larry Goelz will write an article about the Chop Shop Bar in Seabrook, NH. The Chop Shop is looking to host a cruise night please read the next newsletter for more information.

President, Dan Feidler took the floor.

Under Old Business, Dan mentioned that on a Saturday in the not too distant future GCCC will hold a special meeting at MacMulkin Chevrolet where members can brainstorm and recommend ideas for events for the 2010 calendar year. Dan said that he hoped we would have good turnout for that meeting (similar to that of this meeting/35 members).

On Saturday February 21st the Calendar of Events published by Seacoast Vettes needs to have our decision about running our GCCC annual advertisement. The cost is \$149.00 for a $\frac{1}{2}$ page advertisement (the club's normal practice) or \$99.00 for a $\frac{1}{4}$ page ad. Lynn Nault said she felt it is good to support the Calendar of Events and Dean Gagne said there are fewer car shows in 2010 so it will be important to highlight GCCC's annual Spring Fling Car Show (to insure people know it will still take place). Norm Wood made a motion to take out an advertisement (similar to last year). Dean Gagne stated we would need to rework the ad as there will not be a Corvette's Conquer Cancer event. Allie DeCampo asked about the deadline to determine if we would have time to rework the ad. Dan showed our previous ad and it was clear we could easily move items around without difficulty (there was enough content). Norm made a motion for a $\frac{1}{2}$ page ad and Allie seconded the motion. All members were in favor of running a $\frac{1}{2}$ page ad in the 2010 Seacoast Vettes' Calendar of Events.

Dan reported that he and Norm have discussed possibly approaching Tommy MacMulkin, Junior about giving new local corvette buyers (who purchase corvettes at MacMulkin's Chevrolet) information about GCCC and offering them free 1st year GCCC memberships in an effort to boost membership.

Dan announced that the Board has appointed Dean Gagne as the Director of Spring Fling and that he will begin discussing the event in greater detail in March.
