#### A National Historic Site & Deli Lunch Cruise

Throughout the country there are an abundance of historic sites that offer a look back to places which have had a significant impact on the success of our country. Some are well known, like Gettysburg National Military Park, and others are smaller and not on many folks list of things to do. New Hampshire has 23 National Historic Landmarks and I would expect most have not visited most. Next door in Massachusetts, there are 189 such sites.

The National Park Service is an agency of the United States federal government that manages all U.S. national parks, many American national monuments, and other conservation and historical properties with various title designations, including the Historic Sites and Landmark sites.

The Springfield Armory National Historic Site is about 2.5 hours from New Boston and is easily accessed via I-90. This site has been on my list of places to visit but as things went, it was only after 4 years that last month Ingrid and I decided to make it happen. As it happens, our favorite New York Style Jewish Deli is located in Monroe, CT which as it turns out is 35 minutes from the Armory and a great lunch destination. The GPS addresses for each place was spot on.

We headed out one day this past February at 9:00 AM for I-90 to Springfield, MA. Upon arriving at the Armory, I noticed that the Historic Site was much smaller that I had imagined it would be (based on reviewing the Armory's web site https://www.nps.gov/spar/index.htm ). However, touring the facility proved to be well worth the visit as the Armory had a large impact on this country's growth and development, and the collections are well worth the visit. I should note that most of the original buildings are still there, however, most have been repurposed, with a great many now being used by the Springfield Technical Community College.

Begun as a major arsenal under the authority of General George Washington early in the Revolutionary War, the first national armory began manufacturing muskets in 1794. Within decades, Springfield Armory had perfected pioneering manufacturing methods that were critical to American industrialization. Reopened in 1978 as the Springfield Armory National Historic Site, the original 1840's arsenal houses the world's largest collection of historic American military firearms.


We found the information presented was well developed, the collections within are impressive, and the staff was more than willing to answer all questions.

After we left the Armory, we picked up I-91 south then took I-291 heading for I-84 N. Our favorite deli is located in Monroe, CT just off I-84 Exit 65. The deli is Rein's New York Style Jewish Deli and it does not disappoint. They have an extensive menu and I have never been there during a "slow period". You can see for yourself at http://www.reinsdeli.com.

After our enormous corned beef sandwiches (of which we each took half home) we headed north for New Boston. We had a great day, the weather was sunny, the Armory did not disappoint, and lunch was great. How could you go wrong?

Now, what is next on my list of places to visit?

While traveling to Modena to take a turn at driving a Lamborghini on the track, I believe I ran across the only Z06 C7 Corvette in Italy as well!

Stay tuned for the next (and last) installment which will cover our visit to the tropics. Stay warm!


















That Poor Vette... Larry Shields
