



# **2024 National Corvette Museum Caravan Update**

#### NOVEMBER 2021

- NCM announced 2024 Caravan Chair (Over all Captain) Frank Sancineto, a member of RTP Corvettes and Queen City Corvettes in North Carolina.
- The 2024 Caravan has 25 Regions with 16 having Captains identified.
- NCM will open registration for the 2024 Caravan in the fall of 2023.
- The official NCM 2024 Caravan Web site is now up and running <a href="https://www.corvettecaravan.com/new england/">www.corvettecaravan.com/new england/</a>. Click on New England area of the map to access the 2024 New England Caravan information.
- NE Caravan Planning Update:
  - All States/E. Canada have leaders NH State Leaders are Jeff and Alyssa Batula, who also will cover Vermont.
  - O The logo designs are complete.
  - O Clothing has been received and available for sale; current items include denim shirts, polo shirts, and jackets, t-shirts will be available at a later date.
  - NE Caravan routes have been laid out.
  - All hotels have been contracted with Wyndham Hotel in Gettysburg, Hotel Roanoke in Roanoke, VA, Embassy Suites in Concord, NC, Meadowview Resort in Kingsport, TN, and the Holiday Inn in Bowling Green, KY.
  - Events for each leg of the trip have been identified.
  - Three Meet and Greets are in the planning stages first one will be in Hyannis, MA on October 20 23, 2022, with the Double Tree by Hilton Hotels has been booked and registration for this event will open in April 2022; the second will be in the Finger Lakes Region in the Fall of 2023. A third on is being looked into for Spring '23, either in NH (Loon Mountain Resort), or in the state of Maine. However, we are also considering doing the third one in conjunction with the Nova Scotia Auto Show in Yarmouth, Nova Scotia in mid-July 2022.
  - O The October Team Leaders Zoom meeting went well. The next meeting will be in November.
  - 2024 NE Caravan Registration will OPEN on 14 February 2022, Valentine Day!
  - The kick-off for the Caravan will be in Gettysburg, PA, at the Wyndham Hotel (starting on Thursday 22 August; 2-day minimum stay), departing on Sunday 25 August for Hotel Roanoke in Roanoke, VA (driving on part of the Blue Ridge Parkway), departing on Monday 26 August, the

plan is to go to the Virginia International Speedway for track time and lunch, then on to the Embassy Suites Hotel in Concord, NC, departing on 27 August for the Meadowview Resort in Kingsport, TN, departing on 28 August for the Holiday Inn (4 day minimum stay) in Bowling Green, KY, departing on 1 September for Home.


