
First Word


Hello All,

My most recent purchase is a new 2021 Corvette C8 Z51 Retractable from MacMulkin Chevrolet in Nashua, NH. (9 month delivery) At age 79, I received my new '21 and joined Gate City Corvette Club for more "Very Good Years."

I guess I love Corvettes, a great dealership and a great car club!


OUR TRIP TO MECUM AUCTION

Ambassador's NCM Update

March 2022

As the GCCC Ambassador, I have goals to meet for the NCM. For me to meet the goals I need each of you to **let me know** if you attend a museum event, purchase memberships, purchase raffle tickets, purchase bricks/tiles/bench, or make donations to the museum.

Artifact of the Month: Each month, Curatorial staff will select an artifact from the collection that is connected to a significant moment in Corvette history and share its story with you. Long before the factory-backed Corvette Racing team began winning at Le Mans, it was up to "privateer" racers to defend the honor of Corvette on tracks across the country. In those days when GM was participating in a voluntary ban on racing activity, enthusiasts became team owners and ordered their Corvettes from the dealership, and then prepped them for racing. For teams that did well, they might begin to see heavy-duty parts show up from Chevrolet Engineering for "testing" on track. Grady Davis, Vice President of Gulf Oil, was one such privateer. Using Gulf Oil research and development resources, and some clandestine heavy-duty help from Chevy engineers, his Corvettes would dominate. Chevrolet dealer and racer, Don Yenko, began driving Corvettes for Gulf Oil Racing in 1961 and won the National Championship that year with co-driver Dick Thompson. On February 11, 1962, his Corvettes began their season at the Daytona Continental race, winning it and going on to take the B Production class championship in 1962 and 1963 with Gulf Oil Corvettes. This Croton watch was given to Don Yenko by Grady Davis after the 1963 racing season. The watch is engraved on the back "To Don from Grady '63".

Often referred to as the world's largest moving automotive event, the National Corvette Caravan is a celebration of America's Sports Car, culminating in Bowling Green, Kentucky for the anniversary celebration of the National Corvette Museum. Hosted only once every five years, the next event is slated for Labor Day Weekend 2024 and will mark the Museum's 30th Anniversary.

Regional caravans will form and join other caravans as they travel across the United States to meet in Bowling Green, KY for four days of festivities at the National Corvette Museum.

2024 NEW ENGLAND CORVETTE CARAVAN UPDATE

2024 NE Caravan Registration IS OPEN!!!

- Note that the National Corvette Museum registration for the 2024 Caravan is separate and will not open until the fall of 2023. If you did not receive a registration form from Randy Flock, go to the 2024 New England Caravan web site and you will find it there. You will also need to register with the NCM which will open one year out in Sept/Oct 2023. (1 year out.) There is nothing posted at this time on the NCM site. The cost is minimal depending on NCM membership or non-membership. Registration with the NCM gets you a name tag/lanyard, dash plaque, pin, participant decal. Badging gets you into seminars, entertainment areas, displays, etc.
- Registration is limited to 180. As of this update, we have close to 100 registrations. To ensure you are able to participate, send in your registration form as soon as possible.

- ➤ 2024 New England Caravan clothing is available for sale; current items include denim shirts, polo shirts, jackets, and t-shirts.
- ➤ NE Caravan routes have been laid out; all hotels have been contracted with Wyndham Hotel in Gettysburg, Hotel Roanoke in Roanoke, VA, Embassy Suites in Concord, NC, Meadowview Resort in Kingsport, TN, and the Holiday Inn in Bowling Green, KY; events for each leg of the trip have been identified.
- ➤ Three Meet and Greets are in the planning stages. The first one is being held in Nova Scotia on 14 16 July 2022, and the Rodd Grand Yarmouth Convention Center has been booked. This event is in conjunction with the Nova Scotia Auto Show in Yarmouth, Nova Scotia. Registration is open and the event has several openings, so if you want to attend register now.
 - The second Meet and Greet will be in Hyannis, MA on October 20 23, 2022, and the Double Tree by Hilton Hotels has been booked. The registration for this event will open in April 2022.

The third Meet and Greet will be in the Finger Lakes Region in the fall of 2023 at the Hilton Garden Inn in Horsehead, NY.






