Even though a new C8 Corvette is a huge event, and we love seeing how insane the Z06 and ZR1 models will be, the model that is the sweet spot in the line is the new 2027 Grand Sport. Basically, the Grand Sport offers extra performance and styling from the Z06 and ZR1 cars, making it both more fun than the base Stingray, and more accessible than those monsters. Corvette finally revealed it back in March, along with its E-Ray replacement, the Grand Sport X, and it seems to live up to the Grand Sport's reputation. It's also now in production, and Chevy seems to think it's going to be a big seller.
